# Student life in London

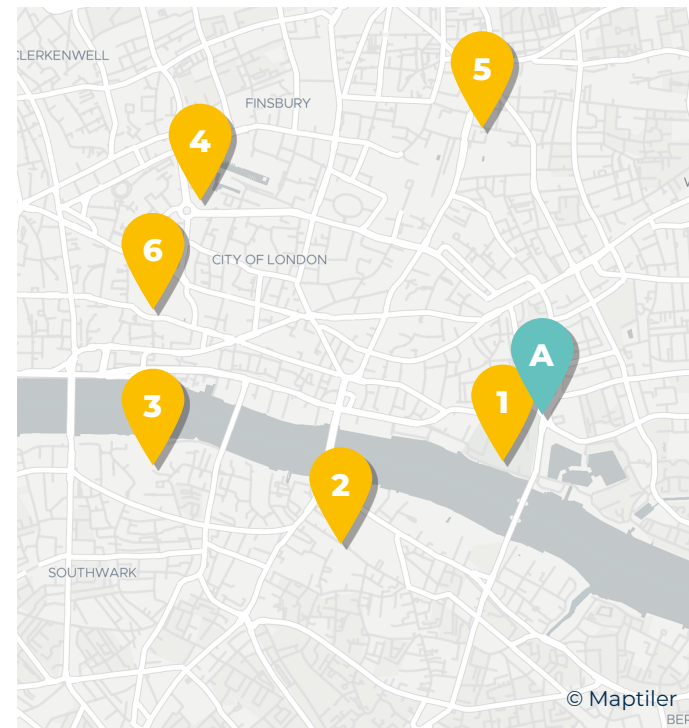
London is home to over 350 thousand students, a third of which are from overseas – making it one of the largest global higher education hubs in the world.

# Student life in Birmingham

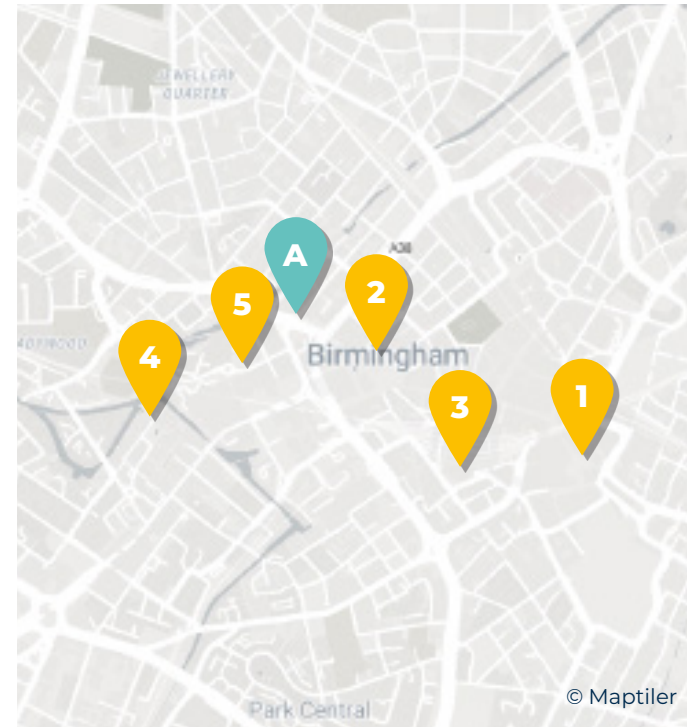
Birmingham is a welcoming city that thrives on its history of multiculturalism.

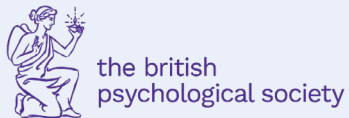

# A guide to the UK visa process

This guidance will assist you in applying for your visa to study in the UK.

We hope that it will provide you with all the information you require to make this a smooth process. However, we will be on hand throughout your visa application journey to assist you with any queries that you might have.

To be issued a student visa you will need to achieve 70 points, by meeting the requirements detailed in the following table, this details the requirements and the evidence required to meet these;



The following table breaks down the points requirements and evidence required to attain them.

## Evidential requirements

The evidence that you will need to provide with your application are;

- CAS – ‘Confirmation of Acceptance to Study’: This will be issued to you by Arden University.
- Qualifications: These will be the qualifications accepted by Arden University that meet our entry requirements. They will be listed on your CAS. You should submit your original qualifications, with certified translations if these are not in English.
- SELT: This is your Secure English Language Test, as listed on your CAS.
- If you are relying on your English as assessed in a previous successful Tier 4/Student route visa application, the CAS used in that application.
- Financial Requirements: These are detailed on pages 45 and 46. You are exempt from meeting these requirements if; You are applying in the UK and you have been living in the UK for the past 12 months or more with permission at the time of your application, we will ask for evidence from you to confirm this; or You are a ‘low-risk’ applicant, you can find a list of low-risk countries at Financial evidence for Student and Child Student route applicants - GOV.UK ([www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk)) please note that despite this exemption, you should have documentation prepared as the UKVI can request this at any time.

## Your Finances

The Home Office has specified the amount of money that you will need to show before they grant you the 10 points towards your Student Visa. If you are studying in the UK (inside London) for the first time you will need:

**Funds required:** Your course fees plus a living allowance of £1,334 (London) or £1,023 (Birmingham) for each month of your course.

**Length of course:** 12 Months



## Financial Evidence Requirements

The Student Guidance states that a banking or building society record would normally:

- be on official stationery or an electronic record
  - be printed or electronic (not hand written)
  - include the account holder(s) names
  - include the account number
  - include the date of the statement
  - include information about the bank, such as contact details or a branch code
  - show transactions and amount held over time (although this is not the normality in all countries)
- Bank statements must be from your or your parent's personal account. You cannot use business bank account statements. If you wish to use a legal guardian's bank statement you must include either your certificate of adoption or a court document naming your legal guardian(s). You cannot use an affidavit
  - If you are using your parent's bank account, you must include your original birth certificate and a letter from your parents giving their permission to use the funds
  - If any of your documents are not in English, you will need to include a translation by a professional translator with your application, details of the translator included
- You must have saved at least enough to cover the cost of living for each month of your course up to a maximum of 9 months
  - The bank statement needs to show that you have held enough money (see above) every day for at least 28 consecutive days prior to the closing balance of your bank statement
  - The bank statement must be no more than 31 days old on the day that you submit your visa application. The date of your visa application is the day you pay for your application online
  - If the bank statement is not in GBP, it is advisable to include a print-out of a currency conversion using [oanda.com](https://www.oanda.com). Due to currency fluctuation, additional of £500 should be in the account





## Immigration Health Surcharge

In addition to the application costs, you will need to pay £470 to cover the cost of National Health Service fees for your time in the UK.

# Visa information for students studying in Berlin, Germany

## How to apply for your German Student Visa

To study long-term in Germany (longer than 90 days), you will need to apply for a Student Visa. You will also need to obtain a Residence Permit once you arrive in Berlin, which you can apply for at the German Foreigners' Office.

Although it may seem daunting at first, the visa application process is nothing to worry about, and our student support team are here to help you with advice and guidance if you run into any difficulties.

We also recommend that international students open a blocked bank account to help the visa application process run more smoothly. A blocked bank account is simply a bank account that contains funds which you will only be able to access once you arrive in Germany. Opening a blocked account will reassure the German authorities that you have access to sufficient funds during your time studying in Berlin.



## Here is a step by step guide to the German Student Visa application process

**Step 1:** Having met the entry requirements for your course and submitted your documents, you will get an acceptance letter from Arden University Berlin.

**Step 2:** Next, contact the German embassy or consulate in your home country to find out about the visa process.

**Step 3:** Prepare your documents as the embassy requests.

**Step 4:** You will have an interview at the embassy to give some background information about who you are and your reasons for travelling to Germany.

**Step 5:** Your visa confirmation will take approximately 2-3 months to arrive, depending on your home country.

**Step 6:** You will receive your Student Visa, ready to join us and start studying in Germany!

## Documents you will need to submit to your local German embassy include:

- A valid passport
- 3 passport photos (with biometric passport specifications)
- Proof of finances
- Letter of acceptance from Arden University Berlin
- Academic certificates from your previous studies
- Proof of English language ability and the Residence Permit fee.

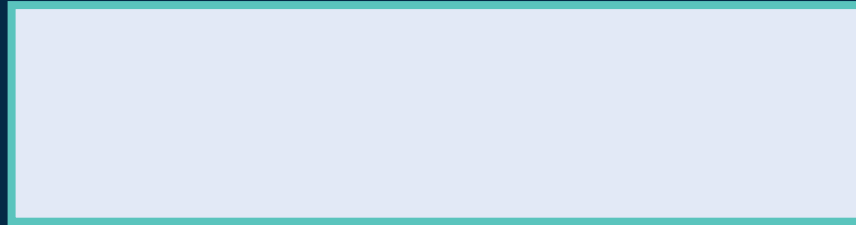
