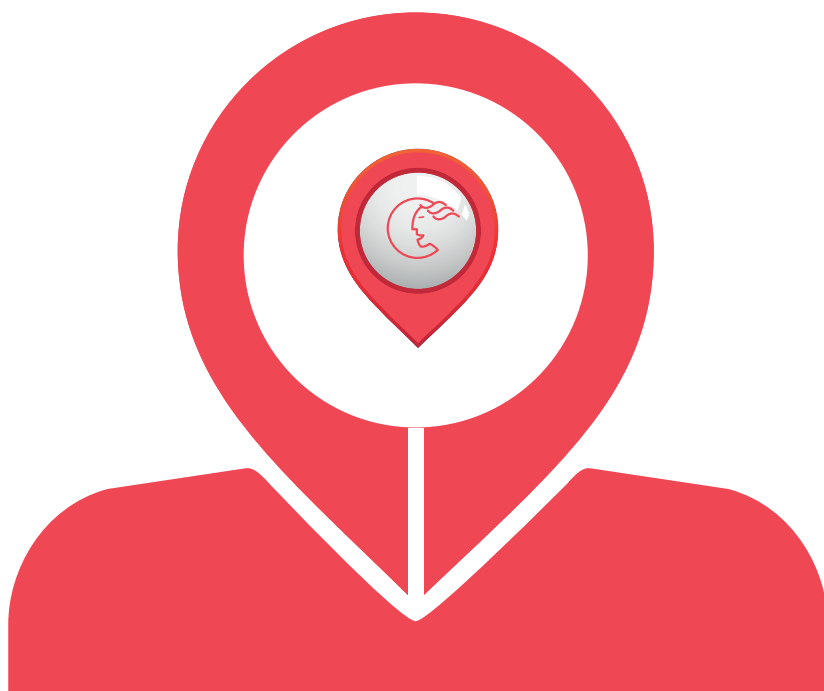


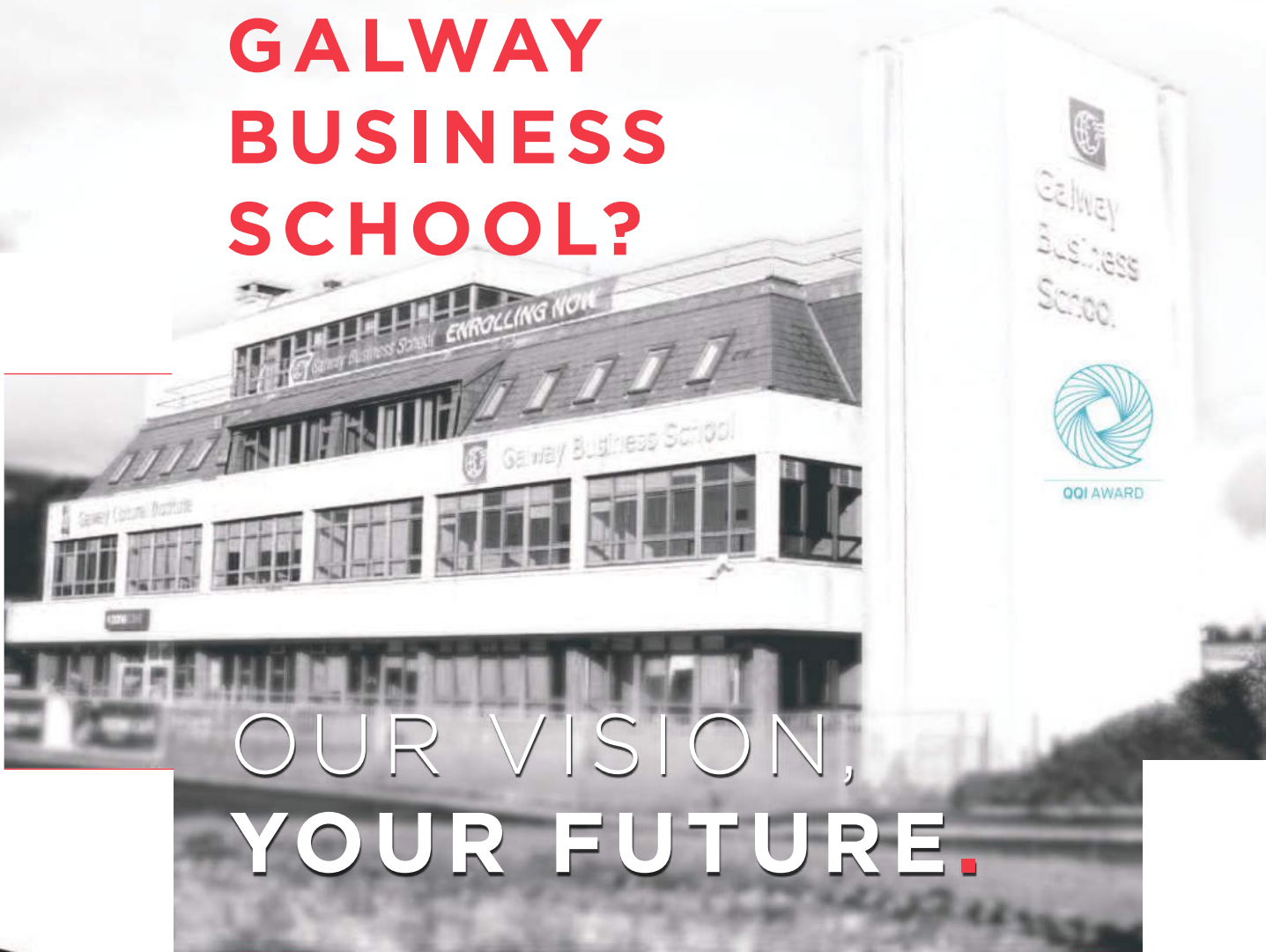

PART-TIME (EVENING)




The Certificate in Data Analytics for Business will provide learners with the key concepts of business data analytics and the fundamentals of business data.

You will acquire a range of cutting-edge, practical data-based skills to enable you to prepare and analyse contemporary business problems within your organisation. In particular, you will learn how to deal with and manage Big Data simulations and apply the techniques to issues of relevance to you and your business. Moreover, you will be able to develop spreadsheet models using pivot tables and learn to apply Visual Basic for Applications (VBA) concepts to real business situations. You will also learn the basics of Machine Learning through coding in Python and SQL. Overall, this certificate is highly practical but underpinned by core analytical frameworks.
