Cost of living in Sunderland

The cost of living in the north-east of England is renowned for being much lower than other parts of the country. Sunderland is the 7th cheapest city for student accommodation according to Student Crowd, and the north-east’s student living costs are around £124 a month less than the national average (Save the Student, 2024).

“I find the cost of living in Sunderland very reasonable. Since I already paid for my tuition, utilities, and accommodation in advance, and I usually walk instead of using public transport, I only spend around £400 per month. Most of that goes toward food and personal expenses. On weekdays, I usually have lunch at the university canteen, and I cook the rest of my meals at home. I often shop at Lidl or Tesco and try to avoid unnecessary spending.”

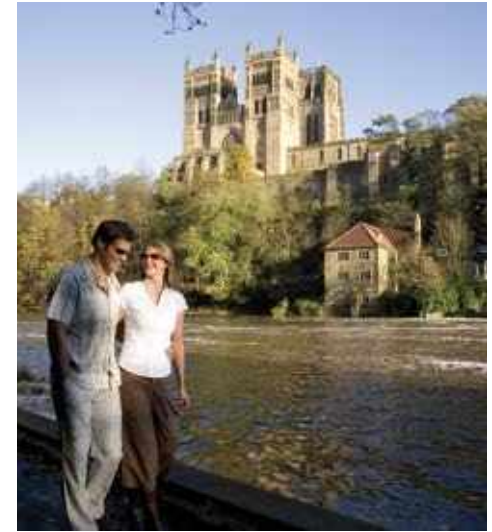
